Grant applications are currently being accepted

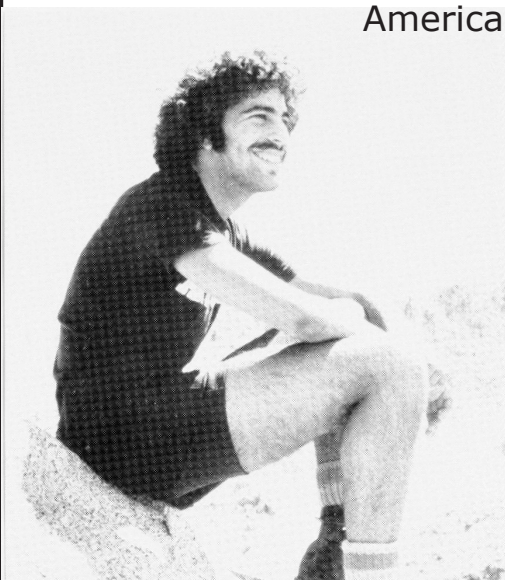
The Joel Frankel Memorial Scholarship awards grant funds to support undergraduate field study projects in Latin America or Latino communities within the United States. While any UCSC undergraduate may apply, priority is given to Merrill College students, LALS majors and Politics majors focusing on Latin American and Latina/o issues. Funds are allocated based on soundness and feasibility of the proposal, evidence of sufficient academic training in the chosen field, and demonstrated economic need.

The fund is named in honor of Joel Frankel, Class of 1979, a Politics major with a strong interest in Latin America. He died of leukemia shortly after graduating from UCSC, and his family and friends established the scholarship in his memory.

Maximum awards is \$600.
