## Course Description

OAKS 185 will train bilingual and/or bicultural students through the Public Health Institute's Tracing Health Program. Students will work as Contact Tracers, supporting marginalized communities who are disproportionately impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic.

Internships are *paid* and will be conducted remotely on weekends.
