

Oakes Student Senate Funding Guidelines 2010-2011

Thank you for coming to the Oakes Student Senate for the funding of your event! Below are the funding guidelines created by the Senate for the 10-11 year. During your presentation to the Senate please try to explain to us how your organization and the event for which you are seeking funding meet these guidelines.

The Oakes Student Senate *will* consider funding if the following questions are answered satisfactorily:

- 1) How does your organization/the event align with at least one of Oakes's core values (diversity, community, and the promotion of the sciences and social justice issues)?
- 2) What is your total budget for the event? How much have you already received and from where?
- 3) How many students are expected to attend the event and of those how many are expected to be Oakes students?
- 4) What will be brought back to benefit the Oakes community from your event?

The Oakes Student Senate *will not* consider funding if any of the following are true:

- 1) Oakes is the only possible source or funding being utilized (exceptions will be made for groups and organizations that are Oakes affiliated).
- 2) The program or event has no clear purpose or goal.
- 3) The budgeting plan is unclear.
- 4) There is not an equal opportunity for ALL students to attend or benefit from the event.

The Oakes Student Senate reserves the right to attach stipulations to any funding we provide. All decisions made by the Senate will be considered final.
