

Oakes needs you! Become an Oakes Course Assistant!

We are now hiring Course Assistants for the Oakes core course in Fall 2017. This is a great opportunity to learn more about teaching and community work, stay involved in the Oakes community, and further explore the themes of the Oakes core course.

Course Assistants work with a core course instructor and help lead class discussions, work with small groups of students, lead out of class activities, and hold a weekly office hour. They also help in mentoring first year/first quarter Oakes students as they transition to college life.

This is not a paid position, but students who work as course assistants will receive academic credit (typically 5 units) for their work. New Course Assistants are also mentored by members of the faculty as well as by former course assistants.
